Cathy reported on the new library garden, with mulch donated by Lowes, and the plan to install micro-irrigation. The Friends may be asked to pay for this.

Molly reported on teen projects and classes at the library. Fall programs will include films adapted from books. The new president of the Teen Advisory Board is Reva's sister, Nadia Gandhi.

Yoga series will start Sept. 7.

Mary will be conducting a series of Arts and Crafts classes. Sign up will be online for each class individually.

Book Sale will start Aug. 31, from 3-7 for Members only. At the end of the sale, books will be boxed and saved for the Book Nook and for sending to the Jail inmates. The feather flag is in the shed. Remaining books will be picked up Tuesday by the Salvation Army.

The idea of special gifts for the volunteers was brought up, as was the possibility of a brunch or other food event. No decision was made. Mary will check into any county requirements for food served at events.

Gene brought up the Friends website. He is willing to work on development and welcomes assistance from any Board Member who has experience.
